
This Appendix A Revision (AAR) is entered into between the Washington State Gambling Commission (State) and the Yakama Nation (Tribe) pursuant to the Tribal-State Compact (Compact) for Class III Gaming, Section XI (A) (Adoption of Regulations and Management). Both parties signed the Compact on June 9, 1996.


To incorporate the use of digital surveillance into **Appendix A, Section 6**, the following changes are to included:

- Change all Appendix A references to “tapes” or “taping” to “original recording”.
- Add digital images recorded at not less than 30 frames per second.
- Add the recording systems must be equipped with an alarm that notifies the operator in the event of an equipment malfunction.
- Add the system is to provide an authentication process such as encryption and/or watermark system to prevent or detect tampering.

Pursuant to the State and Tribe's requests, both agree to the modifications noted above. The Tribe and State further agree that should the terms of this AAR become invalid, by any means or for any reason, the wording of the affected portion of the Compact, as originally worded or subsequently amended, shall immediately be reinstated and binding.
